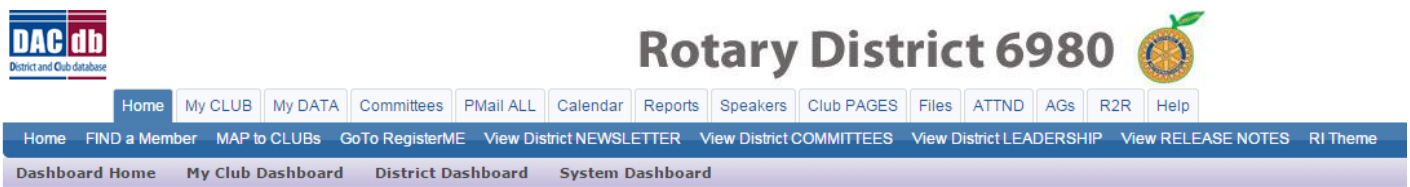
Type in your **email address** your registered with the club click **[TAB]**
